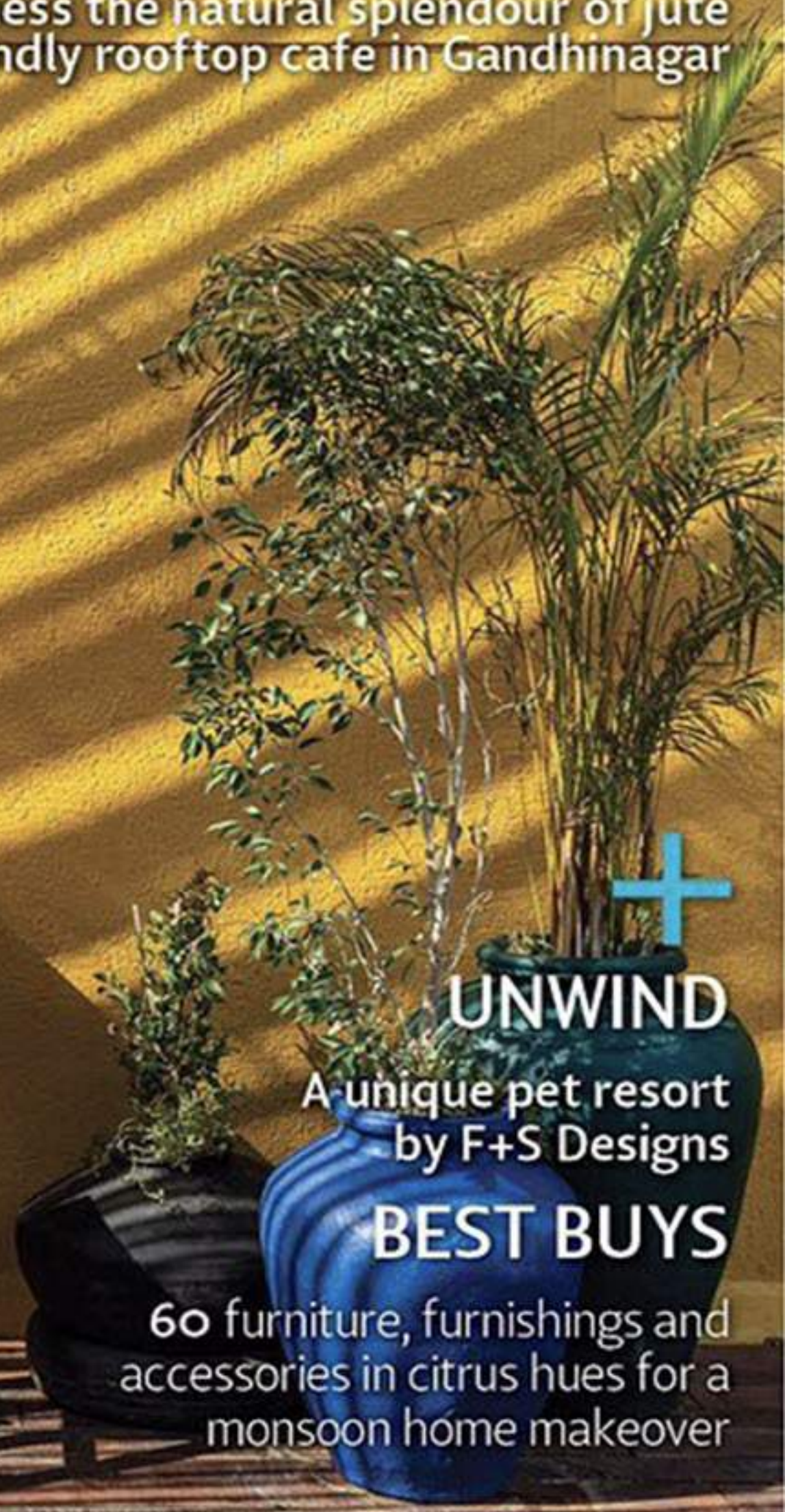

Featured here is the Waves Glass Lamp Stand (right) which has an admiring lotus cut texture and glowing teal colour. The vases line-up includes the Dew, Dunes, Dunes Teardrop, Shibori, Gemstone, Honeycomb and Jewel Glass Vases. The candle holders come in three sizes and encompass the Mosaic and Shibori. ## HERMOSA DESIGN STUDIO

This lifestyle store from Jaipur toasts the design aesthetics of fore with the beautiful Retro Collection crafted from acacia wood. The ensemble seeks inspiration from prints and patterns from the 1960s and 1970s era which are further brought to life in a muted colour palette albeit with a modern twist. For the living room, Hermosa offers statement furniture pieces that are asymmetrical and bold, and showcase a range of quirky prints. We've featured here the Coup Sideboard (top) which provides optimum storage and can be divided into four sections, two sections accessible by shutters and two in the form of drawers. The Ace Ottoman (centre) is contemporary with a classical twist and features solid wood acacia turned legs in teak finish with a seat made of striped quilted fabric in plush velvet feel. The Ortho Display Unit (above) has a carcass made entirely out of engineered wood and features a wooden texture, and a graphic pattern. The pattern is achieved using UVST technology. The base of the unit is made from acacia wood and is finished by staining.
